Gong xi fa cai is how Mandarin-speakers wish you a happy new year—literally "wishing you to be prosperous in the coming year." Most of the overseas Chinese communities speak Cantonese. Gung hay fat choy is how Cantonese-speakers wish you a happy new year—literally "wishing you great happiness and prosperity." This year I am offering the same tour, i.e., the Wheel Base Flamingo Luxury Automobile Rally with enhancements, Mon. Mar. 14<sup>th</sup> to Sat. Mar. 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The Bad News: We have had a tepid response, and the hotels want substantial non-refundable deposits. If by the end of the month we don't have at least 18 customers signed up, we'll have to cancel that Luxury Tour. - III. I cancelled the planned Fall Colors of New England for this year. It's not for lack of interest or participation No, it's because all premium hotels are already sold out in MA, VT, RI and ME. So, the "it's a new world" realization we have come to regarding the planning of trips in the US is that we need to book venues at least 18 to 24 months in advance to secure the parking, luxury accommodations, and restaurant confirmations. Due to the COVID-driven shift in desirable destinations the rules have changed. Thus, I am moving the Fall Colors of New England to 2023 and we have started to select trip dates for 2024.

  - C. The German Romantic Castles PORSCHE FEST is a repeat of last year's Tour. We are again including Berlin, Hamburg, the PORSCHE Factory and legendary Racetrack. The 12 Alpine Passes, PCA Fall TREFFEN, and Beautiful Swiss Alps and the Dolomites (Italy) all look good. I'll be following up with everybody next week.
  - **D.** The **Tuscany PORSCHE Fest**, Mon. Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> to Sat. Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> is **SOLD OUT**. Consequently, I have planned a **second Tuscany PORSCHE Fest**, Wed. Oct. 12<sup>th</sup> to Sun. Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> this second Tour will **ONLY** be conducted if we get **at least 10 couples** (we can take a maximum of 14) registered and committed by <u>no later than</u> (my birthday) April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
  - E. Lastly, we are planning another luxurious AMA River Cruise from Nuremberg to Vienna, plus Budapest, if you'd like to extend it, from Sat. Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup> to Sun. Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>. I am starting this trip with a couple days first in Stuttgart to experience the Christmas Markets, especially the Schlossplatz market. Then a bullet train ride to Nuremberg. All in all, we are planning to visit 10 Christmas markets, including Nuremberg, Passau, Salzburg (Austria), Český Krumlov (Czech Republic), the monastery city of Melk, Vienna and Budapest (Hungary).
