Subject: My Ukraine Comment; Americans are travelling again;

Switzerland drops all restrictions; and how about some

inner peace?

I. Russia's Invasion of Ukraine: Unbelievable! But not surprising. Peter Kreuziger. Bob Armes and I may be the only ones in our Fast Lane Family who have lived under or experienced Russian occupation and domination in Austria after WW II. I was just two years old when WW II was over, but I remember all through my childhood, the wide-eyed fear on the faces of the adults around me. It was not unusual in those dark days to be told by a teacher or relative "if you don't behave, we'll give you to the Russians." Scary, and I behaved. I also remember on Sunday, May 15th 1955, when I was twelve years old, standing with my mother and tens of thousands of Austrian citizens, in the magnificent Gardens of the Belvedere Castle in Vienna, Austria. On the huge terrace of the Castle Julius Raab, Chancellor, and Leopold Figl, the Foreign Minister, the two Austrian negotiators, held up the signed "Staatsvertrag", i.e., the document signed by the Russians agreeing to their complete withdrawal from the occupation of Austria. Seven million people cheered on that day knowing that the Russians would be gone by July 1955. But as a memorial, no, perhaps as a warning, the Russians left the statue of a fully armed Russian Soldier on top of an obelisk on Schwarzenbergplatz in Vienna watching over the Austrians, that is still there today.



I believe that the Ukrainian invasion was fueled by the isolation and paranoia of the Russian Government. Remember, they don't get out much and all their news is

tightly controlled by the State. Their main, and pretty much, only, newspaper: Pravda – in Russian правда_— ironically means "Truth." Pravda espouses their narrow political understanding and representation of the world around them. Don't forget the Ukrainian language is Russian with a few Polish words thrown in. The Russian's view Ukraine "rightfully" as part of their Russian world. They are frightened that the Ukrainian "contamination" of democracy will spread into Russia threatening the power base of the Kremlin. They can't and won't tolerate this. After our Afghanistan debacle and the absence of a solid southern border, given our current consequential international image of the failures of the US Administration, we are not viewed as a deterrent to Russian ambitions. Their fear of the threat of Ukrainian democracy giving the Russian citizens "wrong ideas" is greater than their concern of the consequences of bringing the Ukraine back into their fold.

On the other hand, **the reality is** also that the distance from Kyiv to Stuttgart is greater than the distance from New York to Kansas City (over 1,200 miles). I also believe that with the Ukrainian "buffer" secure, there is no way that the Russians will move further west through Poland, Moldova, Romania, Slovakia, Hungary, Austria to Germany. They've been there about 70-some years ago and it didn't work out well for them then. I feel very sorry for the Ukrainians, and I pray that they ultimately will fare well with "mother" Russia. I also hope that their "Staatsvertrag" will be crafted ASAP when Russia no longer feels threatened by Ukrainian politics at their doorstep.

again with a vengeance," Wynn Resorts Ltd. Chief Executive Craig Billings said Tuesday of the latest quarter. As more Americans travel, Marriott is seeing greater demand for its high-end properties, CEO Anthony Capuano said on a conference call with analysts Tuesday. At Walt Disney Co's theme parks, business came roaring back in the most recent guarter, with revenue from both domestic and international parks more than doubling year-over-year. "We've got really strong domestic demand," CEO Bob Chapek told analysts. As more Americans venture out, some venues are dropping mask requirements. Disney said that starting Thursday, masks will be optional for fully vaccinated visitors at Disney's outdoor and indoor locations, except for enclosed transportation."

If you can conquer tension without medical help,


If you can relax without alcohol,
