To create a tour requires a minimum of \$12 to \$18,000 investment plus some up-front non-refundable deposits to hotels to hold the required space until enough folks make up their mind to come on the trip. Furthermore, to exacerbate the planning of a new trip, particularly in the US, is the fact that the hospitality industry is trying to make up for three years of COVID losses. For example, the Old Edwards Inn, as other hotels in the US, require 100% of all estimated room payments up front – non-refundable, of course. This is at a stage where we don't know how many people will sign up. In addition, they require 100% of the anticipated F & B (food and beverages) up front. For example, at the farewell dinner of the Carolinas trip in 2020 (the only trip we had that year because of COVID) the F & B manager comes up to me and states "Just FYI, you still have a \$750 credit on your dinner F & B, and our policy is that we do not refund!" We had multiple COVID cancellations on that trip, but the vendors hold our feet to the fire. We lost a huge amount of money in 2020.

What I would really love to **get is a call like this**: "Hi Peter, we are twelve couples and we all have agreed that we want you to design a ten-day tour to . . . etc." Thankfully, Thomas and I have a few folks like that, such as the Don & Mary Alldian Friends Group. Folks who have been on multiple Fast Lane trips and have formed life-long relationships. What has happened to the enthusiasm of the PCA Regions, like the **Lone Star Region** who showed up in Stuttgart with 90 enthusiastic participants in September 1992? So, get your travel group together and Thomas and I will create an

awesome and wonderful experience for you. Like anything else you buy in this world – **larger quantities** will reduce the price and/or might get some memorable suite upgrades. So come on, let's get some groups together for 2023.
