Please note that in 2023 we have reduced the number of our PORSCHE Tours portfolio to 8 trips. Primarily I have enhanced our PORSCHE TREFFEN offerings for next year. Specifically, I had an excellent meeting with Vu Nguyen, Executive Director of the PCA last week, to make the original TREFEN to Stuttgart more attractive to a broader base of PCA participants and to get the PCA logistics and financial support necessary to show the Executives at the PORSCHE Company in Stuttgart and Leipzig that the first and largest PORSCHE Club with 150,000 members supports their PORSCHE enthusiasm with a substantial presence in Germany at a TREFFEN to Stuttgart. I spend about \$2,000/month on TREFFEN ads in PANO and we get a tepid response, at best. Consequently, we are offering three TREFFEN variations next year in both the Spring and Fall – see the table above. All trips will include the NEW PORSCHE Museum and a privileged tour of the amazing PORSCHE Factory in Stuttgart. This year we saw the 911 and Taycan Production Lines among other special departments. Next year promises to be even better.

- A. The **2023 BUDGET TREFFEN** 4 days in Stuttgart including the Cannstatter Frühlingsfest in the Spring and the Cannstatter Volksfest in the Fall a truly local and authentic bash (better than the Oktoberfest in Munich which is primarily for tourists).
- B. The **2023 TRADITIONAL TREFFEN** the same as "A" plus two awesome days of Autobahn driving and enjoying great roads in the ominous Black Forest.
- C. The **2023 DeLUXE TREFFEN PLUS** same as "A" and "B" plus some wonderful Alpine mountains driving and spending a little time at luxurious and romantic **Lake Como**. You'll experience THE best of Germany, Austria, Liechtenstein, Switzerland and Italy. It'll be our traditional **5-country Adventure**TM, which we innovated and trademarked over a dozen years ago. This will be the TREFFEN crown jewel.

We also are giving the participants options as to the **model PORSCHE** they may select for Options B & C by having them reserve it directly with the vehicle provider(s). Some folks prefer a **Boxster** while others want to drive a **Turbo S**. Obviously, there is a considerable price difference, but the benefit is the selection of a PORSCHE that fits their budget.

Working on details, getting quotes from Europe and pricing. Please be patient but **start planning your 2023 schedule!**

NOTE #1:

- Yes, Croatia I will do it, but it'll require a considerable amount of time and effort to create it so be patient you have the dates, so plan on it.
- If you missed **Tuscany** this year 2023 is the time don't wait I have to limit it to 14 couples.

NOTE #2: Currently about 70% of the Autobahn sill has **no speed limit**, a percentage which has been creeping down each year. 
