


II. GOOD NEWS: Your PORSCHE Car Rental has been expanded and facilitated: While in the "old days" we only had black 911's we are now are able to offer a selection of new model PORSCHES – anything from a Boxter 718, 911 coupe or cab, Caymans, Panamera or even Turbos. As a result of this tours enhancement, we have also changed our business model in that we create, design, plan, reserve, confirm and lock in the hotels, restaurants, attractions, and other venues, but you now have the opportunity to choose a PORSCHE that heretofore was not available to you. You'll be renting it directly as would any other rental car. The response from the participants on this year's tours has been overwhelmingly enthusiastic. We have also developed a system to expedite the rental process for you. It gets better every year. However, let me manage your expectations: There is not an unlimited supply of PORSCHES in the inventory, so be prepared to have a 1st or 2nd choice. Even if you are confirmed for a specific model, there might still be a small chance that it's not available, because, for example, the previous renter damaged it and it has to be repaired. On the last 100 PORSCHE rentals we only had one like that, but it was quickly resolved to the participant's satisfaction.
