



IV. Leisure Industry Claws Back Job Losses.

Bars, Hotels and Restaurants Become the Economy's Fastest-Growing Employers. Hospitality companies revive their hiring after pandemic cuts, offsetting slower growth in tech jobs. By Nate Rattner, Danny Dougherty and Alana Pipe.

Operators of hotels, bars and restaurants - hit hard as the Covid-19 pandemic took hold - are now among the country's fastest-growing employers, offsetting a slowdown in techrelated hiring.

The leisure-and-hospitality industry is rebuilding its workforce after cutting back during the pandemic's early days. In contrast, companies focused on providing business and techrelated services have slowed their growth in recent months.

Because the hospitality industry includes a larger number of private-sector jobs than the tech and information sectors, the shift in hiring patterns has helped keep the U.S. unemployment rate at a 53-year low and the overall job market tight.

Peter's Comment: I had my first summer job in the hospitality industry in, yes, 1953 at a resort Grand Hotel Panhans in the Austrian Mountains, renting chaise lounges at poolside to little old ladies. There were virtually no men – they were all killed on the Russian Front or with Rommel in Africa. My mother was the physical therapist and trainer in the hotel's fitness studio. Of course, in those days that term didn't exist. It was called descriptively a Leibesübungsanstalt – same thing, just more precise in German. Every Tuesday the pool was closed to customers so that the Russian occupational soldiers could use the pool. I used to teach an Austrian card game, Schnapsen, played with only 20 cards, to the Russian officers. They loved it. Today the hotel, has been reduced to a 4-star property and caters mostly to Eastern Europeans as illustrated by the languages spoken by the current hotel staff: Czech, English, French, German, Hungarian, Russian, Slovak, Slovenian, Spanish, Ukrainian https://de.wikipedia.org/wiki/Hotel_Panhans

Let's move forward about 70 years. Today, after 45 years of creating "PORSCHE Happiness" for thousands of customers, Fast Lane is rapidly propelling its way back after THE most devastating pandemic in our lifetime. In the second quarter of 2020 our CPA and our attorney advised me "Shut it down, cut your losses, and go sit on the swing on your front porch of your family home in Ohio". I responded that I could never do that. Our multiple-trip customers understood our position on the precipice. My deepest heartfelt gratitude goes out to the three customers, here in Florida, no Fast Lane Travel Family Members, who stepped up to the plate with loans and outright six-figure grants, which enabled us to survive. Thank you so very much! In addition, I sold my beloved '64 356B to save Fast Lane Travel. It really hurt – still does.

We are still nowhere near the 2018 or 2019 PORSCHE trip participation level. At the meeting with key members of the PCA Executive Council in Jacksonville, I outlined the successful history of what we have accomplished for the Club since carrying the TREFFEN Torch since 1975. I underscored that their active support is essential to go forward. We need the enthusiastic support of the Regions and Zones. If the PCA can get 800 onto a cruise ship, surely the Club can get 50 or 60 Club Members to the PORSCHE Factory and Museum in Stuttgart?

Surely the largest PORSCHE Club in the world can "send" more participants than South Africa, Japan, even little Iceland last year sent twice as many participants than the US. I'll

be working with the PCA Executive Council to have more PCA Members enjoy the unequalled experience of driving the German Autobahn (before the "Greens" succeed in implementing speed limits); gasp at the amazing roads and vistas of the Austrian and Swiss Alps; and drive into restricted pedestrian zones with a police escort, something you could never ever do on your own.

More information about the other great 2023 trips such as the Interalpen; the Tuscany and perhaps a couple US trips like Colorado and the Carolinas next week. Please bear with me, at the moment, I'm trying to balance all requests for trips with the reality of Thomas' obtaining hotel space, restaurant reservations, PORSCHE rentals and access to key venue, like the Factory.
