L. A New Year: Our entire team in the US and in Europe is making preparations for our 50th Anniversary Year. I look back with gratitude and satisfaction at what we have accomplished in 50 years for the PCA, the PORSCHE Company, and thousands of customers. 2024 will be "back to the future!" In January 2020 we were high fiving each other about what a great year we'll have – trips are selling out; hotels and cars are lined up – then COVID hit the fan.

A. The PCA, after four years, 1958 – 62, was forced to shut down the first Treffen trips to Germany because they committed to charter flight contracts, which made sense in the pre-deregulation airline era. But they couldn't fill up the planes and the wonderful trips to Germany



ceased. Twelve years later, in 1974, at the behest of my late brother-in-law, Dr. Steven Alexander, I created the first NEW Porsche trip to Germany for the Upstate New York Region. The PCA, becoming aware of that trip asked me to create and implement the NEW PCA Treffen to Stuttgart. Therefore, in 1974, I have re-

established the **PCA Treffen** – the traditional annual pilgrimage to the SOURCE of our passion in Stuttgart, for the PCA. As they say, the rest is history. The trips were so successful, until the 2020 Pandemic, that the PCA decided to rename the domestic trips, formerly known as the "Porsche Escape", as the Treffen North America and then there was a

PCA Treffen at Sea. An independent company is also offering Treffen events such as DRTX Treffen in South Florida.

- B. **Thank you**, it has been a rewarding but also a challenging road. The cost to operate a traditional Treffen trip to Germany cannot be covered by the trip alone unless there are at least 24 to 36 participants. Smaller numbers do not cover the fixed costs of the trip, like tour guides, bus transfers, entertainment and minimum participation requirements for reserved seating at the Oktoberfest or Frühlingsfest, for example.
- C. A little more support with Zone or Region competitions would be helpful. I am meeting in the next few weeks with the folks in Columbia, MD, to generate support for this official PCA event.
- D. Credit goes to several **Regions** who have also raffled off a **PCA Treffen** to Stuttgart at their members' meetings.
- E. A key element is the expectation of the Porsche Executives in Germany to have more "Amerikaner" come to enjoy the hospitality that Stuttgart and Leipzig have to offer. They are always disappointed at the sparse participation on the part of the PCA members. According to Porsche Executives, who welcome us, "Even the small PCI (Porsche Club Iceland) sends twice as many members as the PCA." Now that we're past the Pandemic crisis let's get a group together worthy of the PCA.
- F. Nevertheless, I must compliment some Regions, like the Carolinas, who just raffled off a traditional 2024 PCA Fall Treffen trip to Stuttgart.
- G. **GOOD NEWS:** Europe is back in full swing welcoming us with open arms and open cash registers. Please, I want everyone planning on a trip to Porsche in Europe to book ASAP because the European hotels are filling up rapidly we are not the only ones who want to enjoy the Autobahn and the Alps.

- H. Speaking of Autobahn, the supply of **rental PORSCHES** is limited so please don't delay (I wanted to say dilly-dally, but wasn't sure if that is a word we still use?). We've had a good response to the **Twelve Alpine Passes but** need 4 more couples on that exciting trip.
- I. Furthermore, both **50th Anniversary Trips** in September will be amazing and, based on current registrations, will definitely be sold out soon. I am personally conducting both with the enthusiastic support of our European Team. Porsche is rolling out the red carpet for this special event, as they did in 2009 for our 35th Anniversary.
- J. **The PCA Fall Treffen trips** usually have a much stronger response than the Spring same thing every year.
- II. Tuscany, Sunday, October 6th to Saturday, October 19th, 2024, will be sold out, as every year because it's **THE best Tuscany experience** money can buy. The Photo Rally alone is worth the experience. That's the car you'll get if you don't sign up ASAP.
