TRIP of the Week – DETAILS – the Fall PCA TREFFEN by Fast Lane Travel, Inc. Sunday, September 22nd – Saturday, September 28th.

We're delighted to assist with your flights, pre- and post-trip arrangements, travel insurance, and any other travel needs for our Porsche tour guests. NOTE: If you have a pre-existing medical condition that may cause you to cancel your tour, insurance must be added within 14 days of your initial trip deposit.

Day 1: Sunday, September 22nd - Depart North America

Depart from your home for your overnight flight to Europe.

Day 2: Monday, September 23rd - Arrival in Stuttgart

- Arrive in Stuttgart; check in at Steigenberger Hotel Graf Zeppelin
- Welcome to Germany for dinner and drinks

After you check in and freshen up, you will have some free time until dinner. We recommend that you take a walk to help get over any jet lag. Turn right as you leave the hotel and walk to the **Königstrasse** – a pedestrianonly area with shops, museums, parks, cafes and more.





Day 3: Tuesday, September 24th - Ludwigsburg Palace

Later in the afternoon, you will pick up the **PORSCHE** you selected from the **PORSCHE Museum.** We will drive our PORSCHES back to

the *Hotel Graf Zeppelin* where they will be securely parked overnight.

You will be renting your PORSCHE from the PORSCHE Museum in Stuttgart and the rental cost will be charged directly to your credit card, just like a normal car rental in the US. Our staff will help facilitate the rental process for you. The cost depends on the model you choose. Please provide us with the following for your PORSCHE rental:

- * Copy of Driver's License (mandatory International Driver's License get it at AAA it's easy no testing)
- Copy of Passport (you must have a minimum of 6 months before expiration)
- * Credit card number, expiration date and security code for security we prefer to do this telephonically.
- Note: The PORSCHE Company requires a rental deposit of 2,500 € for a 911 or 5,000 € for a Turbo
- * Since not all models are always available, we need your first, second and third choice of PORSCHE model. Sign up ASAP to enhance the probability of getting your first choice.

YOUR PORSCHE RENTAL INCLUDES:

- Depending on the model, there is a quota of free kilometers included. Note: there may be a charge of 1.10 € for each extra kilometer. On this trip, we are estimating a total distance of 600 km.
- Second driver at no extra fee (requires the same information as the main driver)
- * Comprehensive insurance (2,500 € deductible, 5,000 € for Turbo)
- * PORSCHE Rental from: Wednesday, September 25th 9:00 am to Friday, September 27th 4:00 pm

Please bear in mind that this tour is designed, planned and priced approximately 12 to 18 months prior to the event. Therefore, there is a possibility that certain routes, venues, accommodations and prices may change due to circumstances beyond our control: Acts of God, foreign currency exchange rates, COVID restrictions, local events, traffic, weather or the performance of the drivers renting the PORSCHES.
