I. Spring Break in Mexico:

With the anticipated arrival of thousands for Spring Break, the **U.S. Embassy and Consulates in Mexico** has issued a notice. The notice was

released February 19, 2025, reminding Americans heading to Mexico to travel smart. In their notice, the Embassy recommends Spring Break travelers be informed about issues including not only crime and drugs, but also about drownings, medical emergencies and arrests.

In their release, they recommend to travel smart and be informed. Each year, thousands of U.S. citizens visit Mexico during spring break.

While the vast majority travel safely, visitors should consider the following:

- **Crime:** Crime, including violent crime, can occur anywhere in Mexico, including in popular tourist destinations. See the Mexico Travel Advisory for specific information for each Mexican state.
U.S. citizens should exercise caution in the downtown areas of popular spring break spots. This includes Cancun, Playa Del Carmen, and Tulum, especially after dark.
- **Drugs:** Drug possession and use, including medical marijuana, is illegal in Mexico and may result in a lengthy jail sentence. U.S. citizens have suffered severe illness or death after using synthetic drugs or fake prescription pills.
- **Unregulated Alcohol:** Unregulated alcohol may be contaminated, and U.S. citizens have reported losing consciousness or becoming injured after consuming tainted alcohol.
- **Pharmaceuticals:** Counterfeit medication is common and may be ineffective or dangerous. Buy medication from reputable places and consult a medical professional.
- **Sexual Assault:** U.S. citizens have been victims of rape and sexual assault. Perpetrators may target drunk or isolated individuals or use drugs that alter the victim's physical or mental state.
- **Drowning:** Some beaches have strong currents and rip tides. Beaches may lack lifeguards, warnings, or signs of unsafe conditions.
- **Medical emergencies:** Illness or accidents may require medical treatment or hospitalization. Private hospital prices can be higher than in the U.S. and may require upfront payment.
- **Guns and ammunition:** All guns and even small amounts of ammunition are illegal in Mexico. Violations can lead to lengthy jail time.

- **Arrests:** In Mexico, it is illegal to be drunk and disorderly, urinate in public, or have open alcohol containers in vehicles. If you break Mexican law, you can be arrested.
- **Immigration:** Violating the terms of your stay in Mexico can result in fines and detention.

Lenin Amaro Betancourt, the President of the Tourism Commission Council says the region is anticipating a large crowd for the upcoming Spring Break vacation period. He says businesses and hotels are working on a comprehensive project to strengthen the service and tourist infrastructure of the destination. According to authorities, approximately 35,000 are expected to arrive starting at the end of February to enjoy a sun and sand vacation for Spring Break.

and our good friend and **Mountain Man: Alan Butts**. Tucked away in a remote corner of Eagle County near McCoy, a skeletal beast looms - a tangled, twisting form that might seem alive at first glance. But this creature isn't flesh and bone; it's a mass of antlers, stacked high in a rustic workshop where Alan Butts brings his artistic vision to life. Alan is a dedicated antler collector and has amassed an impressive assortment of these natural relics, some still attached to mounted elk and deer heads. In his hands, these once-majestic crowns are transformed. With careful precision, he carves, grinds, and polishes them into intricate knife handles, delicate jewelry, rustic candleholders, and an array of other handcrafted treasures.



“I like to say I have all the bells and whistles,” he quips, motioning toward an array of his ornate creations. For the past 13 years, Butts has sold his work—along with uncarved antlers and mounted trophies—out of a humble shed beside his home. The weathered structure bears the name *Antler Crafts*, though his business card tells another story: *The Antler House*. Much of his raw material comes from the wilderness itself. Scouring the woods, he searches for naturally shed antlers, each piece a canvas waiting to be reimagined under his skilled hands.
